GP ASIA AREA

Cambodia: Missionaries Tim and Tiffany Gallant reported on two important events in the life of The Wesleyan Church of Cambodia.

- *Spiritual Emphasis Week:* The new school year at the Wesleyan Bible Institute (WBI) began with a Spiritual Emphasis Week led by a Filipino team. The central focus of the week was to examine what it truly means to be called by God to holiness. During the night of prayer and fasting, students' prayers focused on the country of Cambodia, the national Church, and their own spiritual needs to be living holy lives. **Pray** for the students at WBI as they study in order to be better prepared to minister to their fellow countrymen.
- *2007 Youth Conference:* Two youth conventions were held in September, and both were well attended by young men and women of The Wesleyan Church of Cambodia. Nearly 150 youth came from seven provinces. The purpose of WBI and the national Church is to raise up strong leaders, and the youth that attended the conventions are the outcome of the ministries of pastors and teachers. Many young people recognized and accepted the life that God is calling them to as the future of the Church of Cambodia. **Pray** for these young people as they continue to walk with the Lord and make plans for their futures.

GP EUROPE AREA

Albania: The following update is from missionaries Eric and Amber Coulter:

Over the summer months we have seen God deepen our relationships with our Albanian friends. From friends in neighboring communities to the landowners of our flat, we are understanding Albanians in more practical ways. **Pray** for us as we invite our friends to read the Bible with us. Many of them are from Muslim backgrounds.

In August a short-term team held a weeklong kid's club at our church and around 50 children attended. Eric is in charge of the weekly meetings that started as follow-up to this event. Twenty to thirty children attend each weekend. **Praise** the Lord! **Pray** for Eric as he teaches these children from the Bible and directs them in fun games. **Pray** for missionaries Matt and Caryl Aukerman and Amber as they assist Eric with these meetings. **Pray** for these children to see Jesus as their friend and Savior.
